INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The voting rights for the Equity Shares of the Company are one vote per Equity Share, registered in the name of the shareholders.
- 2. Voting rights shall be reckoned on the paid-up value of the shares registered in the name(s) of the shareholder(s) as at close of business hours on October 27th, 2017.
- 3. Voting by Postal Ballot, in the physical form or e-voting, can be exercised only by the shareholder or his/her duly constituted attorney or in case of bodies corporate, the duly authorised person. Voting rights in a Postal Ballot cannot be exercised by a Proxy.
- 4. In case of shares held by Companies, Trusts, Societies, etc., the duly completed Postal Ballot Form should be accompanied by a certified true copy of Board Resolution / Power of Attorney/ attested specimen signatures etc. In case of electronic voting, documents such as the certified true copy of Board Resolution / Power of Attorney, along with attested specimen signatures, should be mailed to the Scrutinizer at secretarial@fsltechnologies.com, with a copy marked to helpdesk.evoting@cdslindia.com, or deposited at the registered office of the Company.

I. INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING BY PHYSICAL POSTAL BALLOT FORM

- 1. A shareholder desirous of exercising vote by physical Postal Ballot should complete the Postal Ballot Form in all respects and send it after signatures to the Scrutinizer in the attached self-addressed postal pre-paid envelope which shall be properly sealed with adhesive or adhesive tape. However, envelopes containing Postal Ballot Form, if sent by courier, at the expense of the shareholder will also be accepted.
